In just the first 2 months of 2023, Medway has had ~80 cases in which it seized a total of 1 ½ kilo of meth, 160 grams of cocaine, 130 grams of fentanyl. 1 gram is like the equivalent to a sugar packet.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chief Birkbeck explained some partnerships with Medway. He expressed his belief that Wayne County needs to have a dedicated agency like Medway that only deals with drug enforcement and that everyone should experience being a Medway agent. • Questions to Valeria regarding the availability of drugs in the high school: perception is that they are easily obtained and vape usage is still high in Orrville High School. Josh made the point that “perception can be deception,” and most youth are not using substances. • Chief Birkbeck mentioned that the youngest person that OPD administered Narcan to was 13 years old. • TIP411 sends tips to OPD and Medway. • Discussion on benefits of DARE program and having prevention education start earlier, i.e., 3rd grade. • We need to have the youth group take the lead of what type of programming we want to help them get the message out that we want positive actions and negative usage
